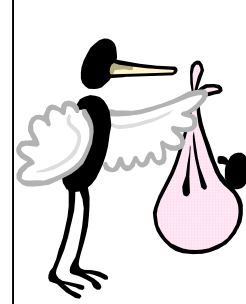

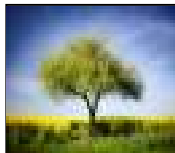
**"30-Hour Famine"**
