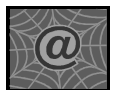

The series will be put into practice with **Family Game Night** on May 17. Parents will challenge the teens in games like volley ball, dodge ball, etc.

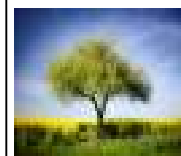


Youth Selling Prepaid Giant Cards
