May 17, 6:00 - 8:00 pm



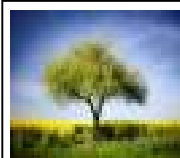

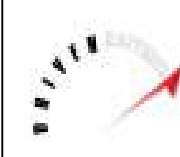
Youth Selling Prepaid Giant Cards

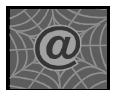
