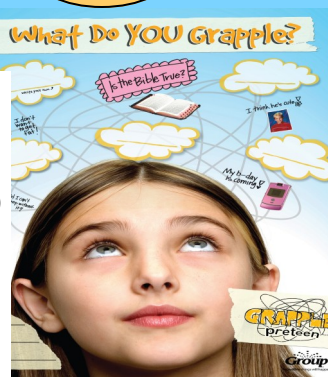

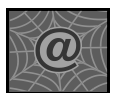

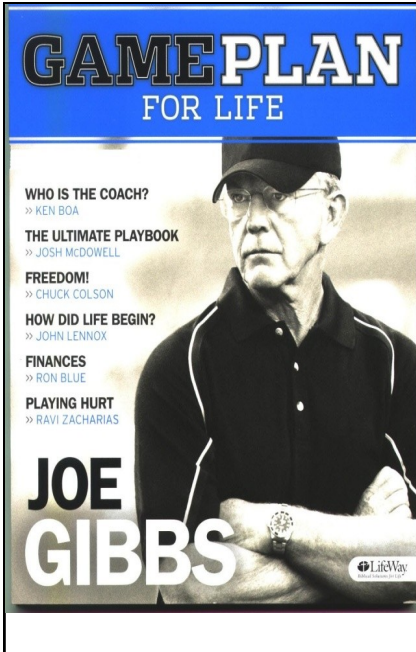
No Children's Church Today
